

Wakefield Conservation Commission
Approved Minutes

Mr. Mankus opened the meeting at 7:02 PM.

Copies of two wetland applications were distributed to members for review. Mr N Fogg noted that he visited both sites on Tuesday, November 20th and found that both plans accurately represented the conditions on the site.

The members discussed the Stephen Caramello, Jr application (TM 141-34) at 245 Veazey Cove Road on Great East Lake. The application was for the restoration and stabilization of shoreline on the property and to rebuild an existing set of steps. The board found the application to be complete and accurate. R Fogg made a motion for the Conservation Commission to sign the application. T Dube seconded the motion. There was no further discussion and the motion carried 4-0.

The members then discussed the Dominick More Revocable Trust application (TM 125-06) at 329 North Shore Drive on Great East Lake. The application is to permit a perched beach to be installed. The board discussed the application and found it to be accurate and complete. T Dube made a motion for the Conservation Commission to sign the application. R Fogg seconded the application. There was no further discussion and the motion carried 4-0.

D Mankus updated the board of the November 15th Planning Board's meeting with regard to the Conservation Commission's recommendation to hire FB Environmental to complete a Natural Resources Inventory to fulfill RSA 36-A:2's requirements. The planning board approved \$8,500, which is less than the fee proposed by FB Environmental. We are awaiting the company's response to the proposed fee.

Members were introduced to Dave Tinkham. Mr Tinkham sent a letter of interest to serve as a Conservation Commission Alternate Member to the board along with his resume. Mr Tinkham lives on Brackett Road; he mentioned that he was pleased with the new drainage structure on Brackett Road, which appears to be minimizing the sediment making its way into Lovell Lake at that location. Members discussed with typical committee activities with the prospective alternate member.

The Conservation Commission will discuss and take action on sending Mr Tinkham's nomination to the Board of Selectmen at their December 10th meeting. The members thanked Mr Tinkham for his interest in becoming a member of the board.

T Dube made a motion to adjourn the meeting. R Fogg seconded the motion. There was no discussion and the motion carried 4-0. D Mankus adjourned the meeting at 7:34 PM.
