

Wakefield Conservation Commission
3-12-2012 meeting
Approved minutes

Location: Wakefield Town Hall 1st Floor Meeting Room
Date: 3-12-2012, 7:00 PM

In attendance: Dave Mankus, Relf Fogg, Steve Brown for missing members to make quorum.

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 PM.

The approval of past minutes was deferred.

Union Meadows: the survey bid package was reviewed at length. The Town Administrator has advised that considering the likely cost involved the Selectmen would be signing the contract and would consider the contract on their meeting on the 3-28-12. The blazing and drying aspect of the contract was discussed. The time line is if approved tonight the Bid Package will be emailed Tuesday 3-13-12 and to submit bids by Friday, 3-23-12, to be opened and reviewed no later than the Conservation meeting on Monday 3-26-12, and a recommendation made to the Selectmen at their meeting Wed. 3-28-12. Mr. Brown made the motion to change the holdback on the blazing portion of the contract to 10%. Mr. Fogg offered the 2nd. Motion carried 3-0.

Mr. Mankus advised that conversations were taking place between him and Linda Schier of AWWA about a possible joint workshop held in the summer to help inform shorefront owners about best practices and regulations relative to large and small construction projects at our lakeshores. Local CEO and State DES personnel as well as local contractors and professionals would form a panel to address regulations and questions. Ideas are still being discussed, possible joint hosting between the Conservation Commission and AWWA, with a date of Saturday, June 23, 2012, from 9AM to noon.
