Agenda out of order:

New Application: Mr. Mankus addressed the application and advised the audience of proper filing procedures. Mr. Fogg advised Mr. Kennedy that the Akers Pine Association application was missing the NHB report. The application was withdrawn pending completion.

Camp: The Commission was advised that between the yard sale & pizza tickets sale, the parents have raised an additional \$995 for camp tuition. The fund is \$52 short. Campers will need to contribute an additional \$6/camper to attend, sending their funds directly to Tanglewood.

Union Meadows:

Mr. Mankus advised the members that Mr. Cook, NH F&G, has all the information needed for the NH F&G grant. He went on to say that the surveyors will be painting blazes in 2 weeks. Lastly, the Watershed Grant application has been submitted. The Commission should know by July 1, 2012 whether or not the \$4,000 grant for purchase preparation has been granted.

Shoreland Seminar: The Commission was advised that the 6-23-12 seminar was a success. Approximately 50 persons, as well as WCC members, a code officer and various state officials attended.

Application/Notification Review:

1. Complaint: File #2011-02847 – Mr. Hendrick was advised that the DES inspection found no evidence of violations occurring in the waterfront buffer area, and will not take jurisdiction at this time.
2. Permits:
  - a. File #2009-02566 – Jk Lovell, LLC was advised that changes to the permit have been approved, construction of a 24'x26' garage to replace a garage that was demolished & replacing 340 sf of paved parking area with gravel & stone.
  - b. File #2012-01458 – Woodman Realty, LLC received permission for cutting.

- c. File#2012-01399 – Larry Knights was given permission to install a foundation under an existing relocated dwelling, construct an attached garage, reduce driveway area and clear for future new septic system.

Correspondence: The Commission received a note from the Society for the Preservation of NH Forests, asking for a report on the Hutchins property.

Mr. Brown made a motion to adjourn. Mr. Fogg offered the 2<sup>nd</sup>. Motion carried. Mr. Mankus adjourned the meeting at 7:48 PM.
