

Conservation Commission Meeting Minutes Draft-June 9, 2014

The meeting was called to order at 7:00pm.

D Tinkahm was seated for S Brown.

➤ **Consideration of Minutes**

- **May 12, 2014**

T Dube made a motion to accept the minutes of May 12, 2014 as submitted. D Mankus seconded the motion. The vote was 4-0-1, the motion passed.

Pride Day

N Fogg stated the Commission gave away trees at the tent on Pride Day. He noted as of today no one has signed up for camp and suggested sending it out through the school again to see there is any interest. It was suggested to forward the information to parks & recreation and the cable TV bulletin.

Conservation Easement Posting

N Fogg noted he has not had a chance to work on this since the last meeting.

D Tinkham stated that he did some research on getting some “no hunting” signs and stated he can get 10 signs for \$11.95 plus shipping. He recommend they do this and put those signs about every 50 feet on the road frontage side.

It was moved by R Fogg and seconded by D Mankus to expend no more than \$20 to purchase “no hunting” signs for the Gage Hill property. The vote was 5-0, it passed.

D Tinkham stated that he also had a chance to look the sign for the property and feels it would not take much to spruce up the sign and volunteered to do that.

D Mankus noted as discussed at the last meeting regarding getting some wood signs made, he has reached out to find the contact in Milton and will let the Commission know when he has more information.

Jim Miller stated the Commission had previously discussed making some short video clips of the Conservation areas and questioned if they still would like to do that. He stated it would be a good way to provide the public with information on the areas.

D Mankus suggested they do a site walk of the property.

N Fogg agreed they could do that at their next meeting on June 23rd and meet at Harmony Drive. He will also check with the Board of Selectmen with regards to getting the rocks moved as suggested by the Police Chief.

T Dube made a motion to adjourn the meeting. The motion was seconded by D Tinkham. The vote was 5-0 in favor of the motion.
