Wakefield and Brookfield residents are invited to participate in a special Household Hazardous Waste Collection Day at the Wakefield Transfer Station. This collection will allow Wakefield and Brookfield residents the opportunity to remove hazardous substances from their homes while ensuring safe and clean disposal at proper waste collection facilities. In doing so, we help keep hazardous substances out of local landfills and homes, resulting in a safer community and a cleaner environment.

Please note: Participants must have a valid Transfer Station sticker to participate. All materials must be in original containers with labels.

From the Yard: Insect spray, Weed killers, Pool chemicals, No-pest strips, Poisons, Charcoal lighter fluid, Fungicides, Fertilizers with pesticides or herbicides, Flea Powder.

From the Garage: Acids, Carburetor cleaner, Creosote, Engine degreaser, Radiator flush, Roofing tar.

From the House: Bathroom cleaners, Drain cleaner, Oven cleaner, Metal polish, Mothballs, Photo chemicals, Rug cleaner.

From the Workbench: Brush cleaners, Corrosives, Rust preventative, Wood preservatives, Paint thinner, Turpentine, Lead and oil based paint, wood stains/finishes/strippers, Solvents.
